
Transitional care is a set of actions designed to ensure the coordination and continuity of care as patients transfer between different locations or different levels of care within the same location

q14	When I left the hospital, I had a good understanding of the things I was responsible for in managing my health.
q15	When I left the hospital I was confident that I knew what to do to manage my health.
q16	When I left the hospital, I was confident I could actually do the things I needed to do to take care of my health.
